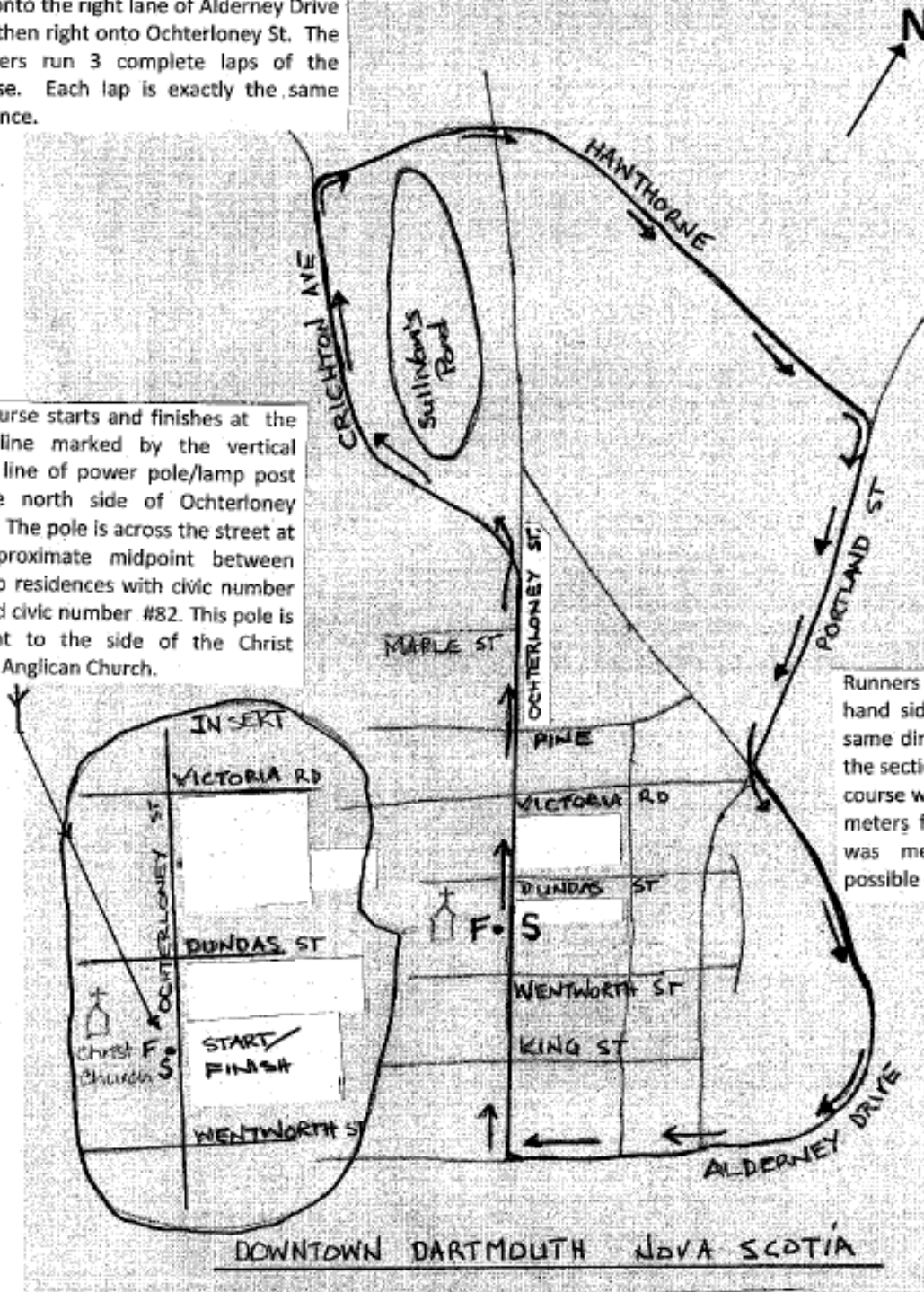


Dartmouth Natal Day 6 Mile Road Race Map

The runners start and run north on Ochterloney Street, veering left onto Chricton Ave and then turn right onto Hawthorne St., right onto Portland St., left onto the right lane of Alderney Drive and then right onto Ochterloney St. The runners run 3 complete laps of the course. Each lap is exactly the same distance.

The course starts and finishes at the same line marked by the vertical center line of power pole/lamp post on the north side of Ochterloney Street. The pole is across the street at an approximate midpoint between the two residences with civic number #80 and civic number #82. This pole is adjacent to the side of the Christ Church Anglican Church.

Runners will be running on the right hand side of the roads running in the same direction as automobile traffic on the sections that are open to traffic. The course was measured approximately 1-2 meters from the right hand curbs and was measured taking the shortest possible distance on Ochterloney Street.
