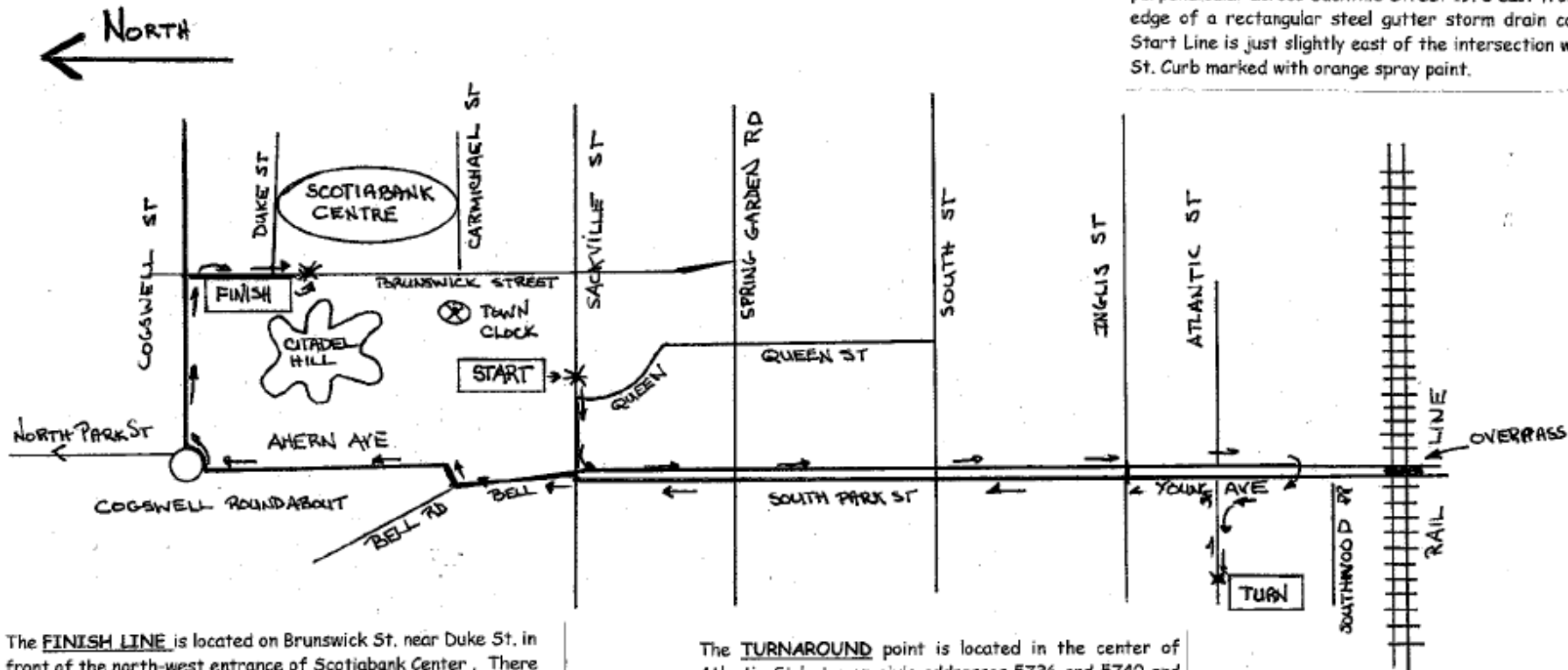

BLUE NOSE MARATHON - 5 KM

The **START LINE** is marked by an imaginary line that runs perpendicular across Sackville Street 19.8 east from the east edge of a rectangular steel gutter storm drain cover. The Start Line is just slightly east of the intersection with Queen St. Curb marked with orange spray paint.



The **FINISH LINE** is located on Brunswick St. near Duke St. in front of the north-west entrance of Scotiabank Center. There are six sets of double doors (12 doors total). The finish line is in line with an imaginary line that is extended from mid way between the second set of doors. (mid way between the 3rd and 4th door.) It is also 3.251 meters north of an accessible parking sign on the side of Brunswick St. Marked by orange paint on the curb.

The **TURNAROUND** point is located in the center of Atlantic St between civic addresses 5736 and 5740 and is 7.8 meters west from the west edge of the rectangular steel storm drain cover in front of these properties. Marked with a PK nail and orange spray paint.

The Blue Nose Marathon 5 KM **START** is on Sackville Street in Halifax on the south side of Citadel Hill just east of the intersection with Queen St.

During the 5 KM the police will have rotating road closures for the participants. The participants run west from the start and turn left onto South Park St. They run south on South Park and continue straight onto Young Avenue facing oncoming traffic. The participants then turn 180 degrees by going around the 2nd median that is in line with the north side of civic address 810 Young Ave. They are now running north on Young Ave facing oncoming traffic. They turn left(west) on Atlantic St. and proceed to the TURNAROUND point and they go around the turnaround pylon and head back east on Atlantic St. They turn left onto Young Ave, and then straight along South Park heading north facing oncoming traffic and they run diagonally across the intersection of South Park St, Sackville and onto Bell Rd. They are now proceeding 'with' traffic flow. They turn right onto Ahern Ave., around the Cogswell St roundabout; keeping right, turn right onto Cogswell St and right onto Brunswick St where they go to the **FINISH LINE** located in front of the Scotiabank Center.
