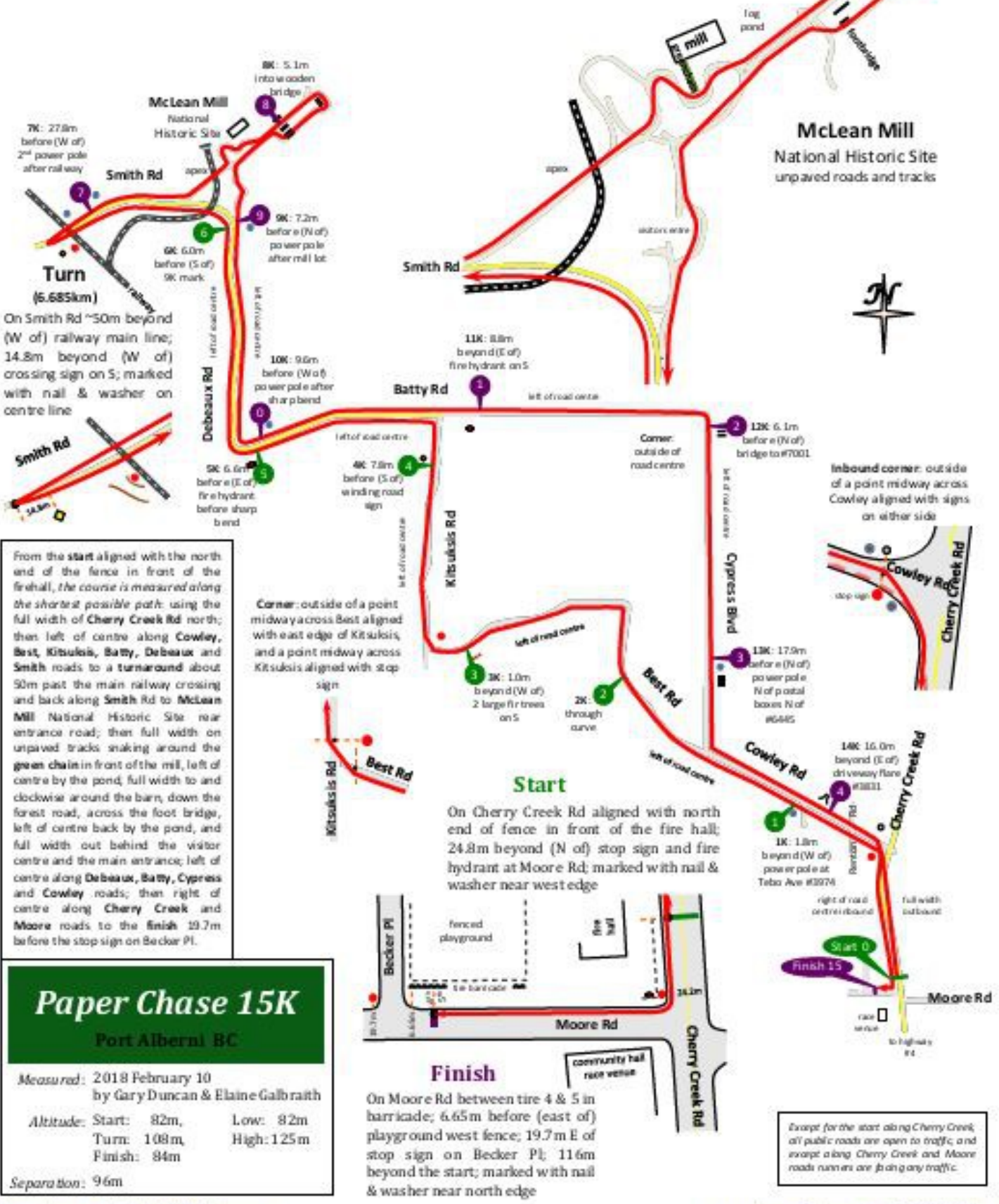

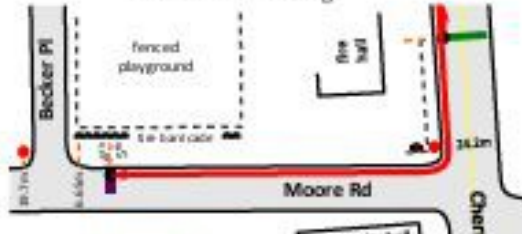
From the start aligned with the north end of the fence in front of the fire hall, the course is measured along the shortest possible path: using the full width of Cherry Creek Rd north; then left of centre along Cowley, Best, Kitsukis, Batty, Debeaux and Smith roads to a turnaround about 50m past the main railway crossing and back along Smith Rd to McLean Mill National Historic Site near entrance road; then full width on unpaved tracks snaking around the green chain in front of the mill, left of centre by the pond, full width to and clockwise around the barn, down the forest road, across the foot bridge, left of centre back by the pond, and full width out behind the visitor centre and the main entrance; left of centre along Debeaux, Batty, Cypress and Cowley roads; then right of centre along Cherry Creek and Moore roads to the finish 19.7m before the stop sign on Becker Pl.

 On Moore Rd between tire 4 & 5 in barricade; 6.65m before (east of) playground west fence; 19.7m E of stop sign on Becker Pl; 116m beyond the start; marked with nail & washer near north edge
