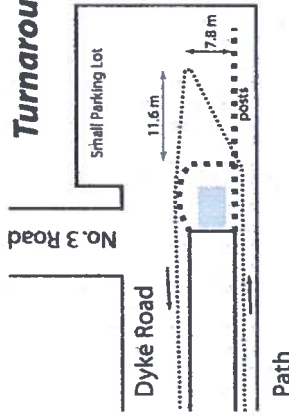
Start/Finish Detail

The START/FINISH is on the west edge of the cement brick that has the words "IMPERIAL CANNERY 1903" inscribed on it.

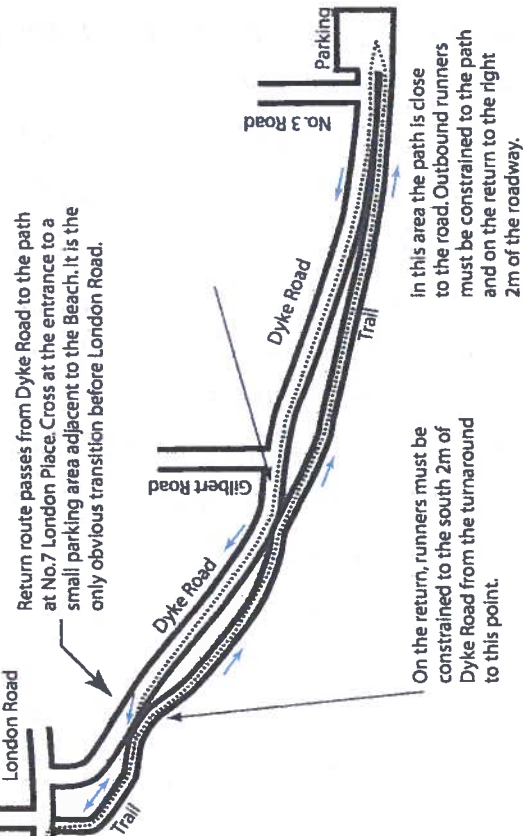


The start and finish is at the commemoration to the BC Packers Imperial Cannery in Steveston.

Turnaround Detail



The turnaround is just east of No. 3 Road, the route goes from the path between the wooden posts to a pivot point located exactly 11.6 m east of the north-south line of posts and 7.8 m north of the east-west line of posts.



On the return, runners must be constrained to the south 2m of Dyke Road from the turnaround to this point.

In this area the path is close to the road. Outbound runners must be constrained to the path and on the return to the right 2m of the roadway.

Notes:

1. The race must be laid out in accordance with this map for the certification to be valid on race day.
2. Runners must be restricted with cones or barriers to the right (south) 2 m of the roadway along Westwater Drive, as shown, and to the left (south) 2 m on Dyke Road.
3. The map is not drawn to scale.
