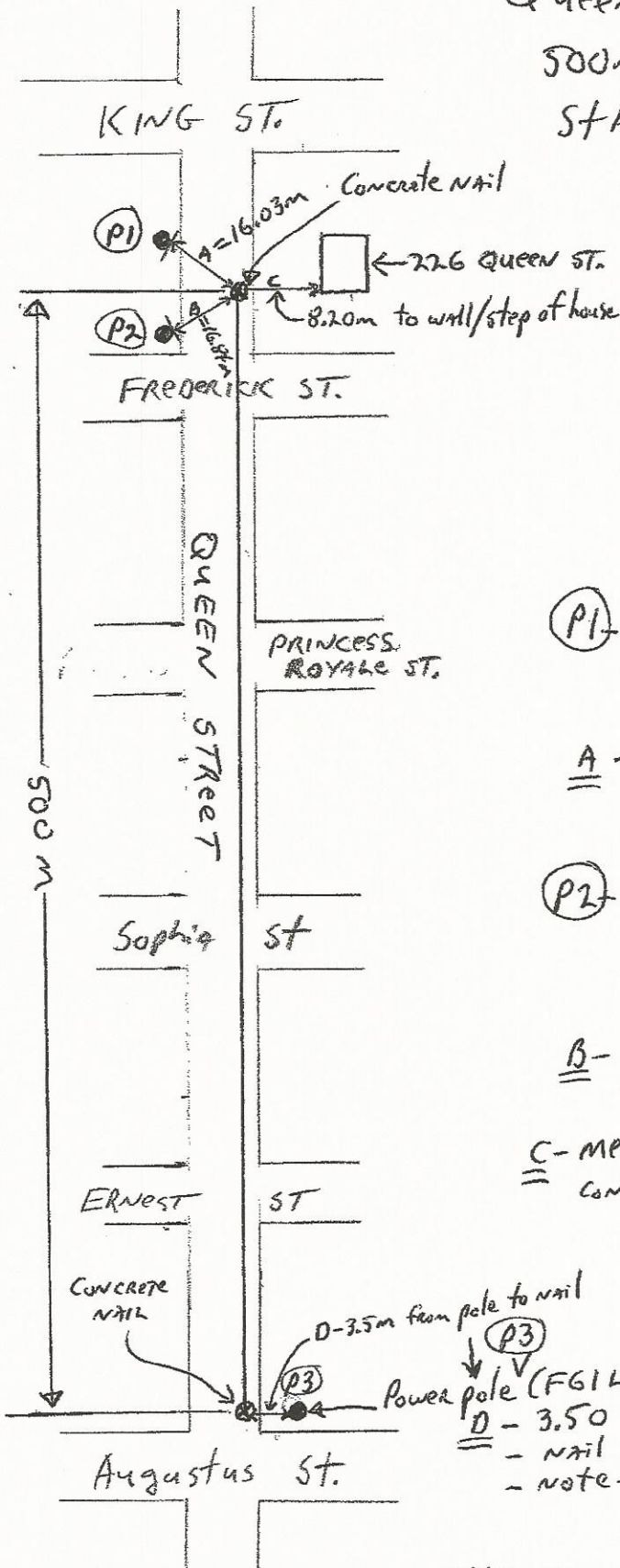

500m calibration course

St Andrews, NB



- the concrete nails (with washer) are
about 30cm from road edge on Queen St.
west east
- but there is no curb
for exact measurement.

(P1) power pole (R3R2, F2260)
at west side of Queen, ~~just~~ north
of north nail

A - measure from P1 to nail = 16.03m

(P2) power pole (L28R3, R4, F232Q)
on west side of Queen street
south of north nail

B - measure from P2 to nail = 16.84m

C - measure from north nail to nearest edge of
concrete wall/step at 226 Queen St = 8.20m

D - 3.5m from pole to nail

(P3) power pole (FG1L1) at northeast corner of Queen and Augustus
D - 3.50m from face of pole to nail at southern end
- nail about 30cm from edge of pavement
- note - no concrete curbing along street
