

Classique du Parc La Fontaine 10k



Course is run entirely on paved surface, a mix of city streets and paths through park.

- 1k On rue Sherbrooke, 8.5m from street light on north west corner of Sherbrooke & Émile Duployée
- 2k In front of 1201 rue Rachel, north west corner of Rachel & De La Roche 9.2 m from street light pole.
- 3k 20.9 m from hockey sign in back of l'Institut de la Santé de Montréal at 1301 Sherbrooke East.
- 4k 2.3m from light post on north west corner of rue Plessis & rue Sherbrooke, in front of 1392 Plessis.
- 5k 7.7m from street light on south west corner of intersection of rue Rachel, rue de Lanaudière & ave. Calixa-Lavallée
- 6k 10.3m from bus shelter on north east corner of rue Cherrier & ave. Parc Lafontaine, and 14.2m from light post on corner of rue Cherrier & ave. Parc Lafontaine.
- 7k In front of 3696 ave. Calixa-Lavallée, 3.6m from parking sign on east side of parking lot on walking path.
- 8k-6.7m from light post on south west side corner of rue Fabre & of rue Rachel
- 9k In front of 3776 rue Parc Lafontaine east side of intersection with rue Roy E.
