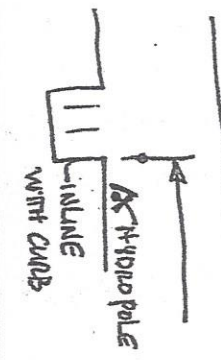

Course Constraints:
Start Line - on Queen Street in line with the concrete post and sidewalk to the Armoury.
Carleton Street - after 2 loops of downtown runners turn right onto Carleton street then onto sidewalk taking walking ramp onto Pedway over St Anne's Point Drive.
Pedway - exit pedway turning right onto paved trail running under the pedway towards the Bill Thorpe Walking Bridge and continue on trail running on right-side.
Gibson Street - course marshals guide runners across street onto unpaved trail.
Canada Street - course marshals guide runners across street onto unpaved trail.
U-Turn point - single pylon in middle of trail mark - course marshals guides runners through turn. Stay on right-side of trail on the way back towards the pedway.
Canada Street - course marshals guide runners across street onto unpaved trail.
Gibson Street - course marshals guide runners across street onto paved trail back to pedway.
Pedway - continue on unpaved trail past the pedway trail till trail ends near the hotel.
Delta Hotel - course marshals guide runners off trail onto sidewalk till Golf Club Road.
Golf Club Road - course marshals guide runners across intersection onto the Valley Trail.
Woodstock Road - course marshals guide runners across road to continue on Valley Trail.
U-Turn point - single pylon in middle of trail mark - course marshals guides runners through turn. Stay on right-side of trail all the way back to the Woodstock Road.
Woodstock Road - course marshals guide runners across road to continue on Valley Trail.
Golf Club Road - course marshals guide runners across intersection onto the sidewalk.
Delta Hotel - course marshals guide runners off sidewalk onto trail back to the pedway.
Pedway - exit trail onto pedway over St Anne's Point Drive taking walking ramp exit onto sidewalk.
Carleton Street - turning left off sidewalk onto Carleton continue to Finish Line
