## ON-2011-113-BDC

LCL - left curb lane  
RCL - right curb lane  
LoWL - left of white line \*  
(\*where no paved shoulder)

Turns that effect distance of race course are made at far side of painted stop &/or go on to new road at its painted stop

Start - 33.6 m west of the first lamp post east of Meloche on the south side of the main road to/from UCCU

- 1 km - 5.5 m north of sign for 3436 Creek Road
- 2 km - 38 m north of sign for 3561 Creek Road
- 3 km - 9 m south of sign for 3671 Creek Road
- 4 km - 18 m west of sign for 3370 County Road 20
- 5 km - 11 m west of sign for 2710 County Road 20
- 6 km - 24 m east of red barn on County Road 20
- 7 km - 3 m west of sign for 1414 County Road 20
- 8 km - 10 m north of sign for 1163 County Road 20
- 9 km - 7 m south of sign for 899 County Road 20
- 10 km - 7 m south of sign for 663 Dalhousie
- 11 km - 29 m south of gate to Coast Guard on Dalhousie
- 12 km - opposite front door of 172 Dalhousie

- \* Enter south entrance to Fort Malden and exit to right of first building at south entrance off Laird St.
- \* Rest of half marathon not marked.
- \* Runners to use splits of marathon for the rest of the half marathon
- Half Marathon - 67.0 m before the finish.
- Finish - same as start
