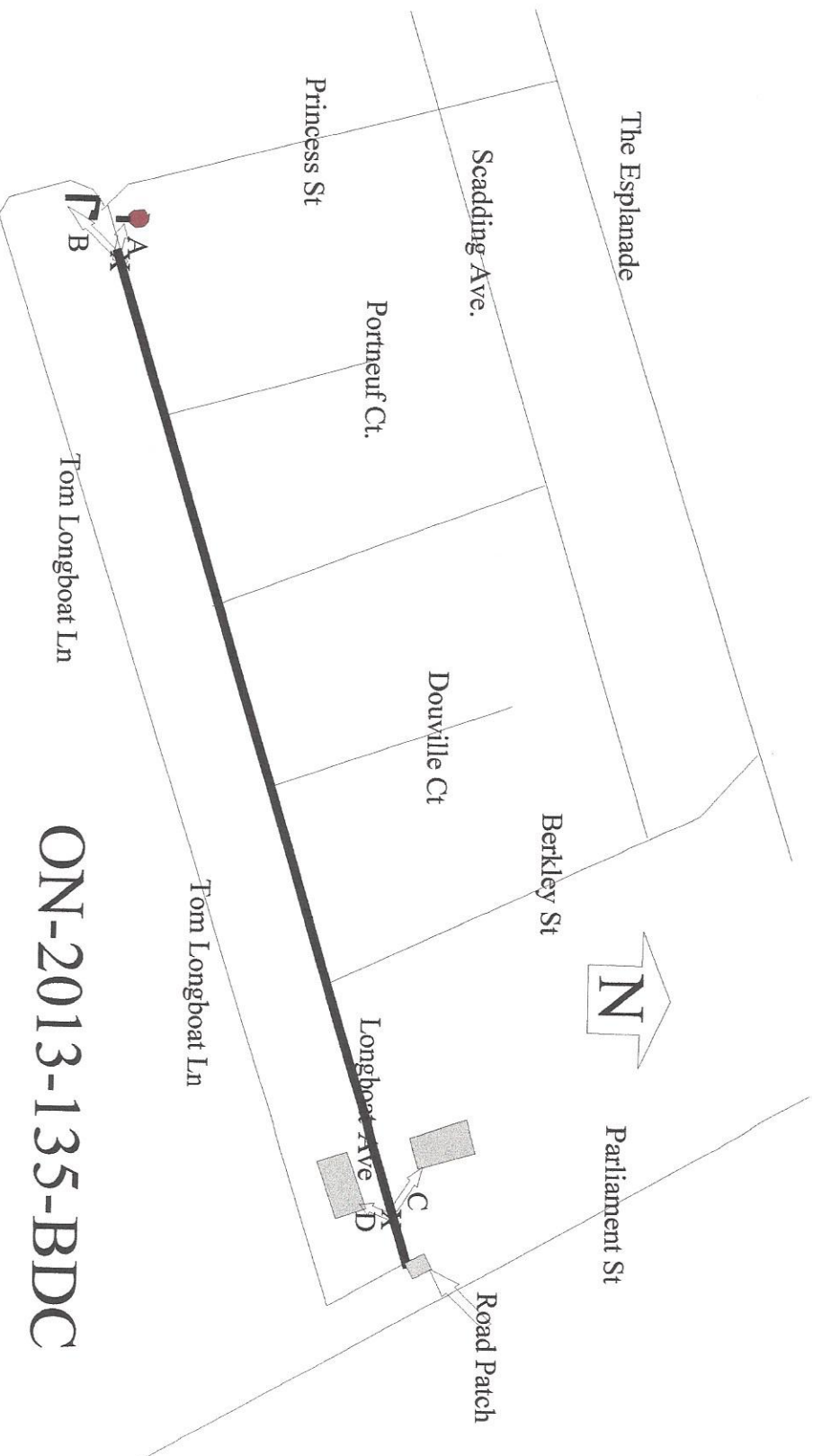

- C - 8.775 m to corner of building
- D - 7.942 m to corner of #449 Longboat Ave.

The calibration course is down the centre of Longboat Ave. There is a cut that has been tarred that was used to keep the calibration course straight and is ridden when calibrating the bike. At the east end there is a road patch and at its west side it forms a T where the one nail is positioned
