South End – concrete nail is situated at the west corner of the paved pathway where it meets the plaza stones.

North End – on the east side of the paved pathway which is 9.94 m to the north of the north side of the concrete block for the light standard on the east side of the pathway just north of the Dinsmore Bridge.

Note – nails are on opposite sides of pathway at either end due to slight curve in the pathway.
