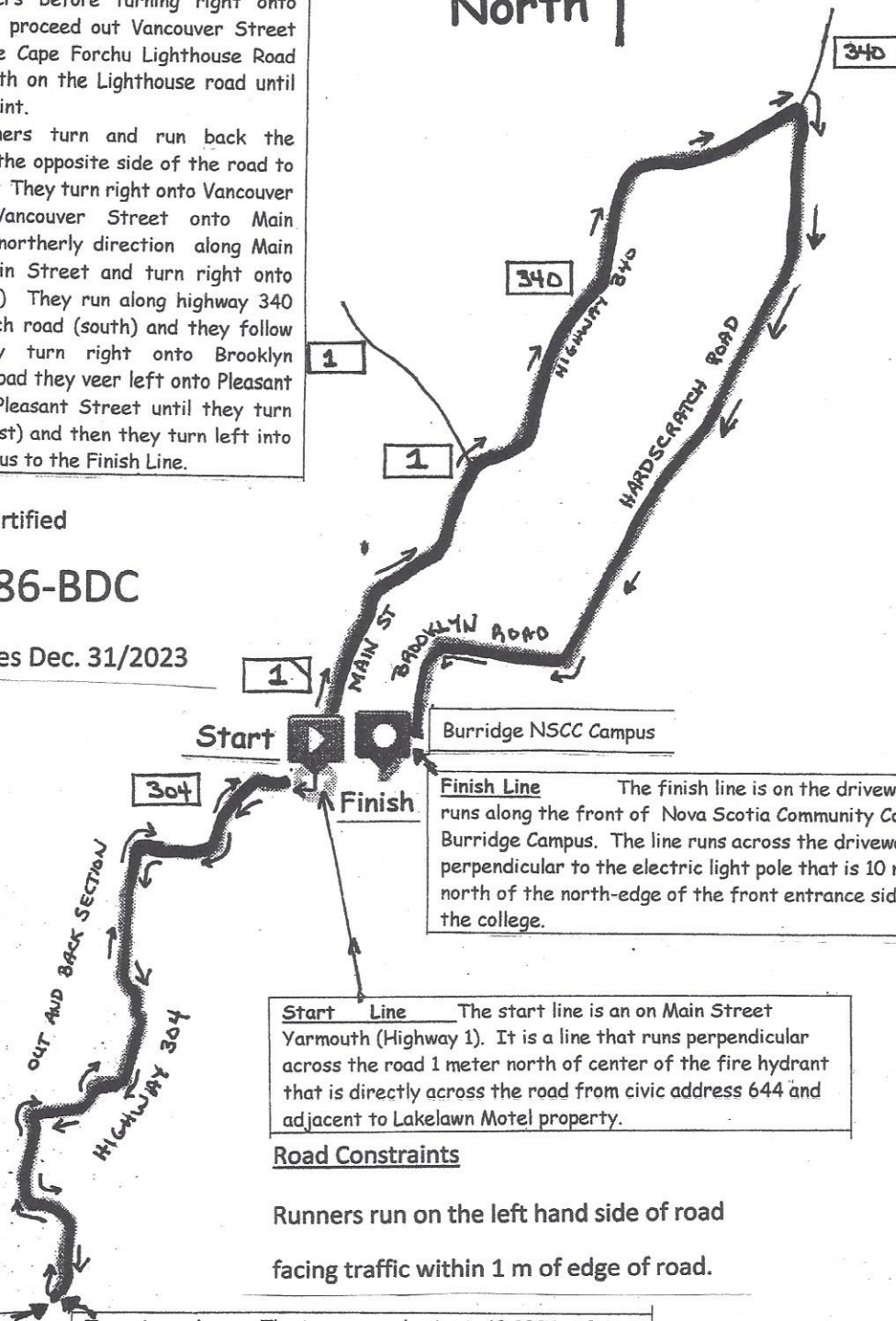

**Yarmouth 'Bean There Ran That' Marathon 2014**

After the start the runners run in a southerly direction for a few meters before turning right onto Vancouver Street (west) and proceed out Vancouver Street until they turn left onto the Cape Forchu Lighthouse Road (Highway 304). They run south on the Lighthouse road until they reach the turn-around point.

The runners turn and run back the lighthouse road (Hwy 304) on the opposite side of the road to the outbound runners. (north) They turn right onto Vancouver Street (east), Left from Vancouver Street onto Main Street (north) and run in a northerly direction along Main Street. They run along Main Street and turn right onto Highway 340 at Hebron (east) They run along highway 340 turning right onto Hardscratch road (south) and they follow Hardscratch Rd until they turn right onto Brooklyn Road (west). From Brooklyn Road they veer left onto Pleasant Street (south) and run along Pleasant Street until they turn right onto Hibernia Street (west) and then they turn left into the driveway of Burrige Campus to the Finish Line.

**Finish Line** The finish line is on the driveway that runs along the front of Nova Scotia Community College; Burrige Campus. The line runs across the driveway perpendicular to the electric light pole that is 10 meters north of the north-edge of the front entrance sidewalk to the college.

**Start Line** The start line is an on Main Street Yarmouth (Highway 1). It is a line that runs perpendicular across the road 1 meter north of center of the fire hydrant that is directly across the road from civic address 644 and adjacent to Lakelawn Motel property.

**Road Constraints**

Runners run on the left hand side of road facing traffic within 1 m of edge of road.

**Turn Around** The turn-around point is 10.082 km from the start line on highway 304 where the highway meets the asphalt parking lot of Cape Fourchu Lightstation. A narrow concrete sidewalk on the left side of the parking lot marks the point where the highway and parking lot meet. The turn-around point is in the centre of highway 300 in line with a line perpendicular to the leading edge of this sidewalk.
