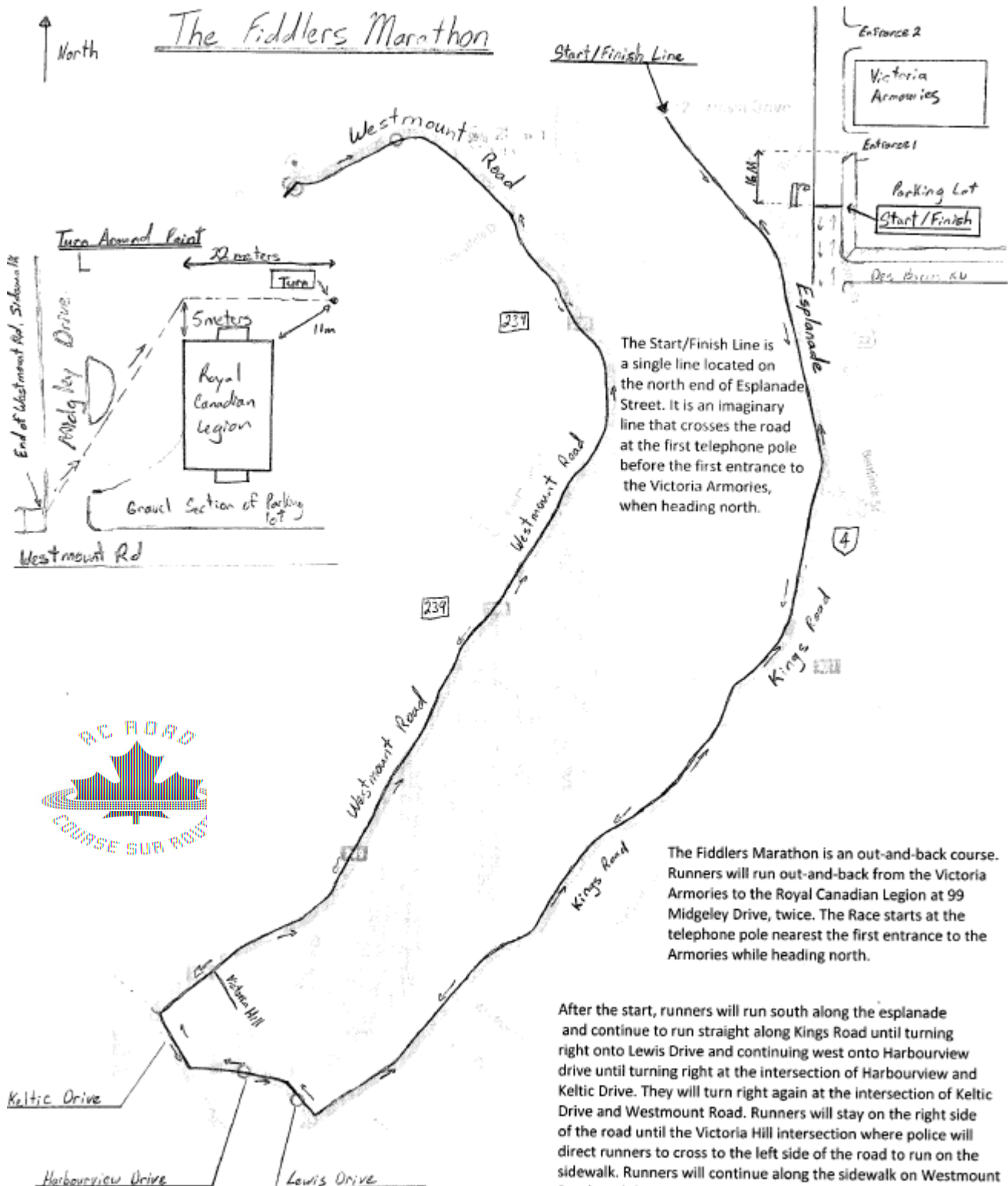

The Fiddlers Marathon is an out-and-back course. Runners will run out-and-back from the Victoria Armories to the Royal Canadian Legion at 99 Midgeley Drive, twice. The Race starts at the telephone pole nearest the first entrance to the Armories while heading north.

After the start, runners will run south along the esplanade and continue to run straight along Kings Road until turning right onto Lewis Drive and continuing west onto Harbourview drive until turning right at the intersection of Harbourview and Keltic Drive. They will turn right again at the intersection of Keltic Drive and Westmount Road. Runners will stay on the right side of the road until the Victoria Hill intersection where police will direct runners to cross to the left side of the road to run on the sidewalk. Runners will continue along the sidewalk on Westmount Road until the sidewalk ends at the corner of Westmount Road and Midgeley Drive. Runners will turn left onto Midgeley drive and then immediately turn right into the Legion parking lot where they will turn around and return to the Victoria Armories along the same route, and the same side of the road, as they came.
