## Sarnia Run The Runway Terminal Start

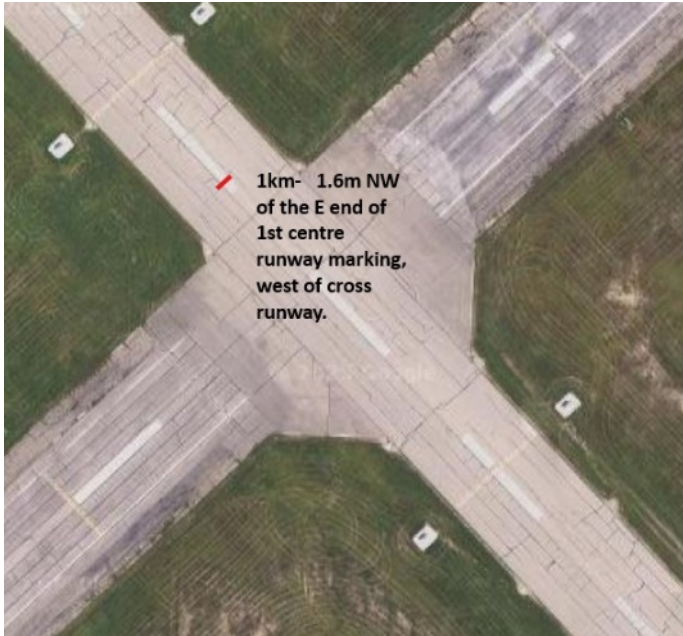


Runners start 13.3m directly in front of the power supply in front of the terminal building, they proceed north east and make their way to the main runway following the shortest route while not crossing the lines marking the edge of the runway. Once they reach the main runway the turn left (NW) and make their way to the turnaround on the centre line of the runway. Once around turnaround #1 they follow the centre line to turn around #2 at the SE end of the main runway. Turnaround #2 marks the halfway point and runners will retrace their path to the finish.



Start/Finish- 13.3m directly in front of power terminal with 2 red lights seen in picture.
