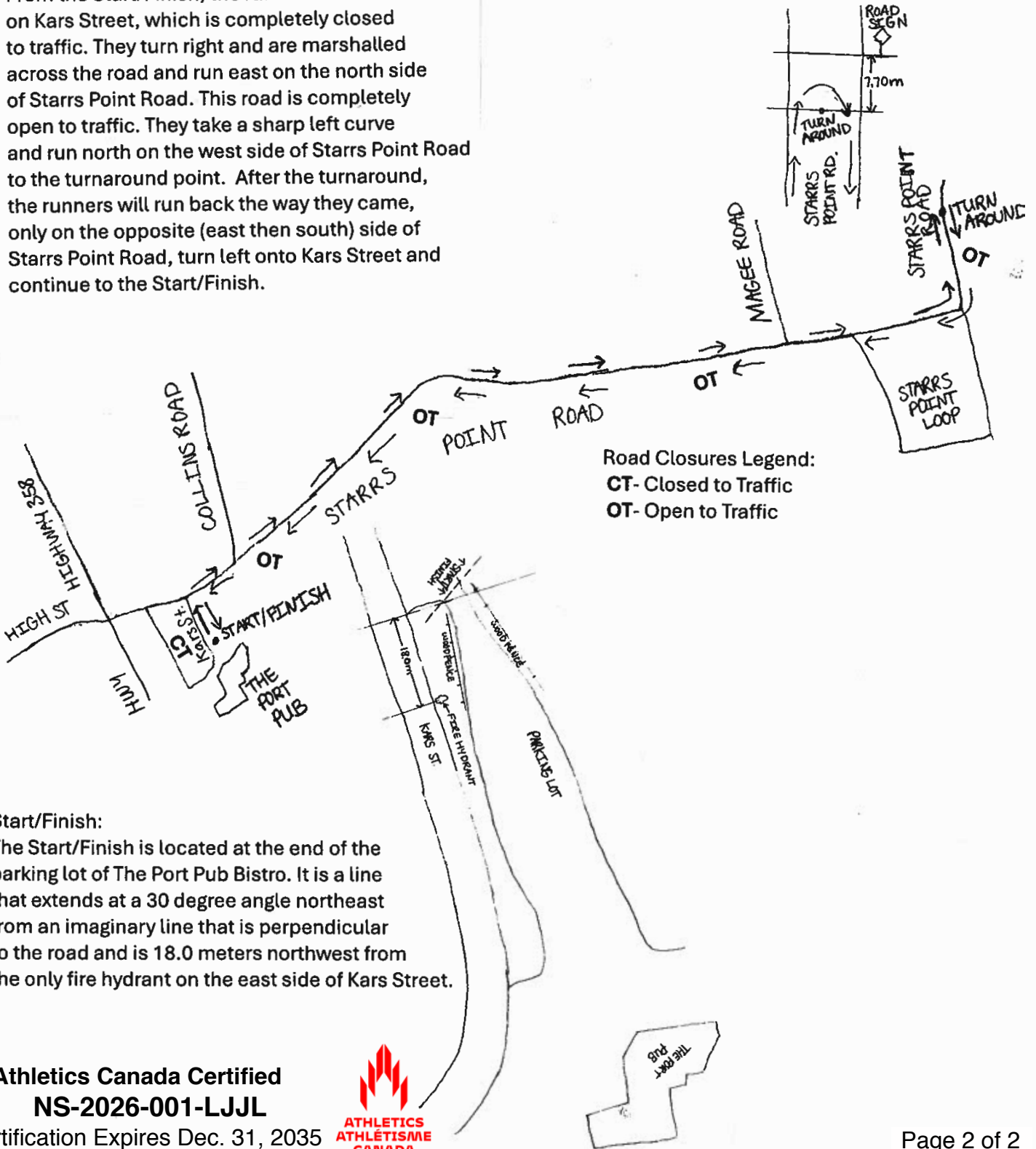


Turnaround Point:

The turnaround point is located in the center of the road on an imaginary perpendicular line which is exactly 7.70 meters south from another imaginary perpendicular line that extends from a 50km/h road sign that is on the east side of the road. The nearest civic address to this road sign is 1600-1776 Starrs Point Road.

Course Description:

From the Start/Finish, the runners run north on Kars Street, which is completely closed to traffic. They turn right and are marshalled across the road and run east on the north side of Starrs Point Road. This road is completely open to traffic. They take a sharp left curve and run north on the west side of Starrs Point Road to the turnaround point. After the turnaround, the runners will run back the way they came, only on the opposite (east then south) side of Starrs Point Road, turn left onto Kars Street and continue to the Start/Finish.



Start/Finish:

The Start/Finish is located at the end of the parking lot of The Port Pub Bistro. It is a line that extends at a 30 degree angle northeast from an imaginary line that is perpendicular to the road and is 18.0 meters northwest from the only fire hydrant on the east side of Kars Street.
